The ultimate responsibility for safety lies with each individual entry. A copy of these Rules will be given to you upon receipt of your parade entry form. Your submission of the parade entry form indicates that all those associated with your parade entry have agreed to adhere to these Parade Rules.

Photography waiver: Pictures may be taken of children participating with the under signed participant/organization in the Clover Christmas Parade and used for future event publicity.

Waiver & Indemnity Agreement: I hereby release, indemnify, and hold harmless Greater Clover Chamber of Commerce, the Town of Clover, or any of its employees or volunteers for any loss, damage, or injury resulting from my participation in the Clover Christmas Parade. I have also read the above parade rules and agree to abide by them. Failure to comply with the rules will result in removal from the parade. The entrant will be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses that occur as a result of failure to comply to the rules.

Please initial that you have read & will abide by each of the following Parade Rules

- _____ Each entry must have a decorated identifying sign. It must be large enough to read from the front or both sides
- _____ Each entry must have some type of holiday decoration (e.g. tinsel, garlands, bows, lights, etc)
- _____ You will receive a 24 hour notice and a full refund if the parade is cancelled due to weather
- _____ Participants are NOT permitted to throw candy or other objects during the parade. It is VERY dangerous to children running in the street to gather candy, etc. Violators will not be permitted to participate in the future.
- _____ Persons shall remain on the unit to which they are assigned to the end of the parade route, except in case of breakdown or emergency.
- _____ All entries are encouraged to be picked up at end of the parade. If your entry goes back to the starting point, please use extreme caution!
- _____ **The Parade Day Representative MUST attend one (1) of the mandatory meetings. This person will be the main point of contact for your group on parade day and will be the one responsible to relay information to your group. If your representative does not attend a meeting, your group will NOT be permitted to participate.**
- _____ Line-up information, maps and additional information will be given at the mandatory meetings.
- _____ Information MUST be relayed to all participants in your group. If you need assistance with this, please speak to a GCCC representative.
- _____ An adult representative from your group MUST be present in the staging area with any children from your group. Our volunteers will not be responsible for your specific group.
- _____ Participants MUST be dropped off in their designated areas at their designated times. **Absolutely no one should be dropped off on Highway 321.** If someone from your group drops a participant off on Highway 321, your group will not participate in the parade the following year. Our primary concern is for everyone's safety!
- _____ **Road barricades will NOT be moved.** Anyone caught moving barricades or driving in areas where not permitted will be removed from the parade line-up and will forfeit entry for their organization for the following year.

HORSE ENTRIES ONLY

- _____ **There is a mandatory \$100 clean-up deposit** for ALL horse entries.** No horse entry will be accepted without deposit
- _____ ALL horse entries are required to provide their own clean-up crew to shadow their entry OR have horses wear a catch apparatus. **If clean up crew or apparatus is not worn, then clean-up deposit will be forfeit.
- _____ Safety is our top priority for all entrants. We have chosen a secure area to stage you and your horses with plenty of room to groom and walk your horse until your line-up time. Horse entries must stay in the provided staging area until our staff leads you to your line-up area.
